STEP 1: DECLARE CANDIDACY FOR OFFICIAL DEGREE

In order to officially graduate, students **must** declare candidacy on GOLD even if they are not planning to participate in a commencement ceremony. Refer to the Graduation tab on GOLD.

The following deadlines apply:

Spring 2019

February 19, 2019 through April 15, 2019

Summer 2019

February 19, 2019 through July 8, 2019

Fall 2019

February 19, 2019 through October 14, 2019

Don't Forget!

Declaring candidacy to receive an official degree and making a commencement reservation are two separate steps on GOLD!

STEP 2: MAKE A COMMENCEMENT RESERVATION

Seniors in the College of Letters and Science and College of Engineering declaring degree candidacy in 2019 who wish to participate in commencement must make a reservation for their major ceremony using GOLD beginning at 9:00 a.m. February 19, 2019. Students may only make a reservation for the ceremony associated with their declared major. Immediately after reserving your major ceremony on GOLD you will be re-directed to Marching Order to input the phonetic pronunciation of your name for announcement during your ceremony.

The last day to make a 2019 commencement reservation is March 24, 2019.

Note: there is only one 'pass time' to make a commencement reservation in 2019.
